Guide to mourning practices – 3 sessions - \$25 for text used [October 17, 24, 31 1:00-2:00]

A brief overview of the stages of public mourning and the role of the community

How to read Torah – 10 sessions - \$10 [October 10, 17, 24, 31, November 7, 14, 21, December 5, 12, 19 9:30-10:30]

This course will culminate in several assigned readings for the spring and summer

How to chant Haftarah – 5 sessions - \$10 [January 9, 23, 30, February 6, 20 9:30-10:30]

This course will culminate in assigned Haftarat during the summer and fall

A real quick overview of all the books within the Torah, Nevi'im (prophets) and Ketuvim (writings), with some exposure to various methods of critically reading the text

Introductory Hebrew [Begins Sunday October 3 at 9:30-10:30, Thursday October 7 at 7:00-8:00]

This is for students who have never learned the alef-bet and vowels. The textbook used is *Shalom Aleichem* by Noah Golinkin, ISBN 0-88482-696-1

Intermediate Liturgical Hebrew (timing worked out with students beginning in October)

This is for students who know the alef-bet and vowels, but have not done anything with Grammar. The textbook used is *Prayerbook Hebrew The Easy Way* by Anderson, Motzkin, Rubenstein and Wiseman, ISBN 0-939144-12-3

Stalking the Siddur – seeing what the Hebrew means for ourselves [Beginning Thursday October 7 at 7:00]

This is for anyone who is able to follow along in Hebrew during services, and would like to understand more of what they have been reciting. We will learn grammar as we go and as it appears in the text.

Advanced Biblical Hebrew (timing worked out with students beginning in October)

This course assumes knowledge of the topics covered in Intermediate Liturgical Hebrew
NJOP Crash course in Basic Judaism
NJOP Crash course in Jewish History
NJOP Crash course in Holidays
